

## List Of Indian Books Compiled

A list of more than 100 audio-visual aids on the American Indian for classroom work, including films, film strips, recordings and posters, has been compiled by Zenas J. Kevorkian and Prof. J. Louis Giddings curator of the Indian Museum at Mt. Hope, who conducted the summer course on American Indian Backgrounds at the Brown Uni-

versity summer school.

A list of more than 100 books on the American Indian, suitable for reference or classroom use, has been compiled by Mr. Kevorkian, a member of the Cranston High School faculty, who during the past summer was a course consultant in the Graduate Summer School for Teachers at Brown University.

The lists were drawn up after careful and extensive study of books, films and other available material dealing with the Ame-

rican Indian. Much of the material was discarded as not giving a true picture of Indian life, only authentic material being retained in the lists.

Both lists have been assembled in pamphlet form and are available in limited quantities at the university's department of education for reference and classroom use by teachers. The grades for which each item is suitable, from elementary to the college level, have been specified in the listings.
