Blades Are 4000 Years Old

PROVIDENCE, R. I.—Mrs. J. Louis Giddings, widow of the late Brown University anthropologist, examines two tiny blades which were carefully fashioned from flint by people of the so-called "Denbigh" culture in northwestern Alaska some 4000 years ago. The blades were discovered by a Brown University expedition at Onion Portage on the Kobuk River, 100 miles inland from the Chukchi Sea that separates Alaska from Siberia.
